Headlice

Headlice are in school again. **PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CHECKING THEIR CHILDREN'S HAIR FOR HEADLICE AND EGGS.**

Please be responsible and check your child's hair daily, especially on the hair behind the ears, nape of the neck and close to the scalp. It is extremely frustrating for families who are checking and treating their child's hair to keep getting re-infected and also for school staff who are at risk of infection. If children have hair that is longer than shoulder length can you please make sure that it is tied back when they are at school. This not only helps to stop the spread of nits but is also safer during P.E lessons and more hygienic during lunchtime.

Some chemists are part of the NHS Minor Ailments Scheme and will provide headlice treatment free of charge if you do not pay for your prescriptions. Please talk to your local chemists to see if they are part of this scheme.

Winter Mornings

Can we please ask that if it has been frosty and the car needs to be cleared or if the footpaths are going to take a bit longer to walk on that you allow the extra time to get to school.
