What have the Infants done this week?

The children have had a great week. We have continued with our work on the theme of 'Space'. The children finished work on the book '**Whatever Next**' by writing a letter from Baby Bear to Mummy Bear. We have now embarked on another lovely story about a little lost alien called '**Beegu**'.

In maths Year 2 have been partitioning numbers, Year 1 have been practising accurate counting and our Reception child has done lots of matching digits to numbers of objects and counting accurately.

We have also learned about the life of **Neil Armstrong**, about different sorts of weather and how to record them using symbols, team games outside and done lots of reading amongst other things. Year 1 & 2 have spellings to practise for next Friday so please keep up the practising at home together with the normal reading. The children did very well with their spelling 'test' this Friday. It was informal and they were not at all phased by it.

What have the Junior's done this week?

What a busy week! This week the children have been concentrating on using the most appropriate, most powerful descriptions in their writing and we will continue to build our description of a setting from the film Wall-e next week. In maths we have been exploring Place Value. Next week we will be using this knowledge to count on and back in different amounts, round and order numbers. The children have been challenged to identify features from satellite images and have also created powerpoints of the solar system. Next week we will be concentrating on the 4x table and hopefully starting to build our droids. **Please can the children bring boxes, tops, containers, tubes, bottles etc. that they can use to build their robot designs.**
