Child Absence

Please can we remind parents to telephone/inform school of your child's absence and that this is done before 9am each day (unless it is a 48hour sickness bug).

Wrap Around Care

Please can we remind parents that children require booking into our wrap around care and clubs the **Friday before via an email to the school office**. It is important that we are aware of the expected numbers so we can order sufficient food/snacks. Staff members leading the clubs will therefore be aware in advance of confirmed numbers. In emergencies, we will try to cater at short notice, however, this is not always possible.

As a school, we must follow our safeguarding and attendance procedures. Parents/carers will receive a phone call if children are booked into breakfast care and do not arrive or are not collected at the time specified from afterschool care.

For those children who attend club, we will be resending our 'School Agreement' for you to sign to ensure we have the correct information on record.
