Class 1

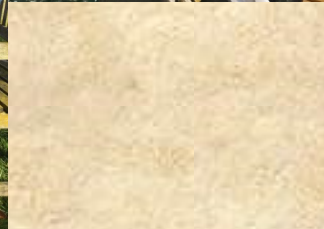

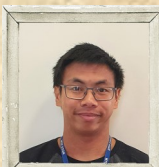
We have created a recycling centre in the class, where the children have learnt about the materials that different items are made from and sorted them into paper, plastic, aluminium and glass.
