Class 2


It has been a lovely week for Class 2.



In maths, we have continued our topic of measurement and we have been measuring the capacity of different objects using millilitres and litres.







We are pleased to share that the winning house this half term is **Goodall**. **The children of the** winning house will have a non-uniform day on Friday 21st July.


Dance Enrichment Day on July 20th
