### Message from the Headteacher

#### **Rocking Romans in Stillington!**

We have been very busy getting ready for our 'Rocking Romans' play, which will be taking place on

Wednesday 12th July at 5:30pm in the school hall.

We would like all the junior children to arrive in school at 5:15pm, dressed in their costumes.

The children can come into school through the front door, but we ask that audience members then go around to the main office reception door to go into the hall.

We respectfully ask parents to ensure that **any younger children watching the play remain quietly in their seat**, so that everyone can hear the performers and appreciate all the hard work that has gone into this production.

#### 'Crucial Crew' event

On Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> July, our Year 6 pupils are taking part in 'Crucial Crew.'

'Crucial Crew' is a multi-agency event organised through schools, by the police and supported by the fire service.

They aim to raise awareness of safety issues to school children in Year 6. To help cover the cost of this educational visit we are requesting a **donation of £5 per child**, which will be added to ParentPay.

Please be aware children will return to school slightly later on this day, at approx. 4.15pm.

### Quidditch Day on July 18th

On Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> July, children in Years 1-6 will be taking a trip to 'Hogwarts' for our Quidditch day!



This will take place at Terrington Village Hall. The bus will depart at 9:15am and return before the end of the school day.

All children are required to come in their PE kit: white t-shirt, black shorts or jogging bottoms and trainers. Children should also wear their school jumper/cardigan and bring their own, clearly named water bottle.

We also ask that children bring a sun hat and apply sun cream before school (a labelled bottle can also be brought with them).

On this day, pupils are required to **bring a packed lunch** from home, unless you have already ordered one from school. **Children in Nursery and Reception will have their usual school lunch.**
