In maths, we have been looking at odd and even numbers. Maybe you could explore house numbers with your child when about!

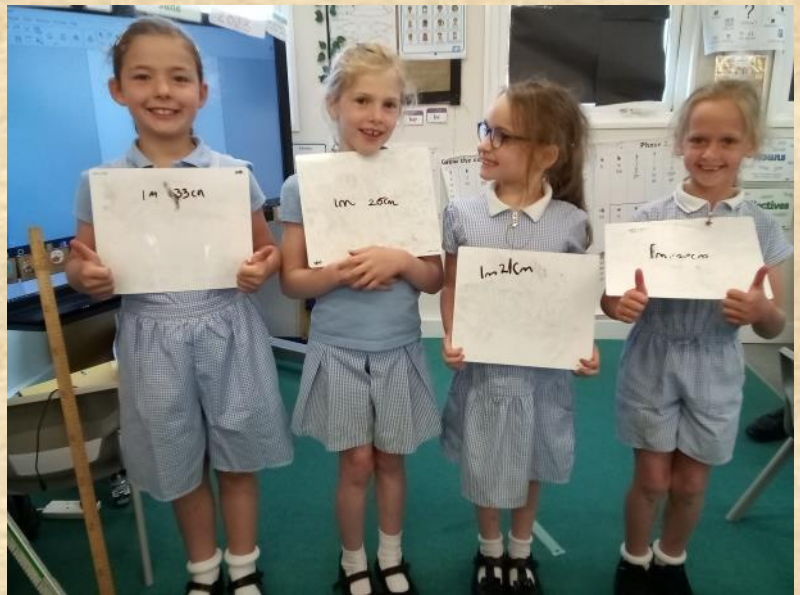
#### Class 2

We are pleased to be taking our EYFS children (Nursery and Reception), across the three schools, on a trip to Askham Bryan Wildlife park on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July. They will be taking part in a 'Habitats' workshop, focusing on animals that live in water, which links to our current "Under the Sea" topic.
