

Stillington Primary School Weekly Bulletin 13th October 2023


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We have been really enjoying autumn this week in Class 1. Across all year groups, we have really loved looking at the signs of autumn, all around where we live and learn.

Children will get dressed in their PE kits at school. Please make sure that they have everything they need.


