We have had another lovely week in the Infants this week—enjoying exploring our topics and learning lots of amazing things.



In Nursery and Reception, the children were fascinated to look at nocturnal animals, linking this to our story, 'Owl Babies.' The children have been creating owls in different ways and using these to help us tell the story. We have also looked at hedgehogs as part of our counting this week.



In Years 1 and 2, we have explored the different settings in our class book. The children have been building up to creating a setting description based on a setting that they have created themselves. They worked really hard to build up the descriptive language in their settings. They have also had great fun in science, experimenting to find the most and least stretchy materials in our classroom.

Earlier this week, they thoroughly enjoyed their session with Mrs Free from Malton High School, who came to demonstrate lots of fascinating facts about how our solar system came into being.
